#### Publication and authorship

The *IKASTORRATZA*. *e-Revista de Didáctica* journal is an academic dissemination journal that publishes papers addressing educational issues.

The *IKASTORRATZA*. *e-Revista de Didáctica* journal does not admit previously published papers and consequently all manuscript submitted have to be original and unpublished. Authors undertake the commitment not to submit the article to any other journal or publication, while their paper in under consideration.

Authors are accountable for getting the appropriate authorization for partially reproducing material (figures, text or tables) from other publications and also for citing their source appropriately. If authors would like to include their article in another publication, the journal where it is published has to indicate the data of the original publication, previous permission requested to the *IKASTORRATZA*. *e-Revista de Didáctica* editors.

For its part, *IKASTORRATZA*. *e-Revista de Didáctica* reserves the right for total or partial reproduction of the papers as well as to accept it or reject it. Together with this, *IKASTORRATZA*. *e-Revista de Didáctica* reserves the right to make any editorial changes that it considers appropriate. In this case, authors will receive written suggestions of the reviewers and, if accepted, authors has to deliver the paper with the indicated adjustments within the dates pointed out by the journal in order to guarantee its publication.

#### Double blind peer evaluation review process

Papers received will be subjected to a process of review and selection. Initially, the Editorial Committee will assess papers' originality and relevance.

Subsequently, a double-blind type evaluation will be undertaken by two referees in order to evaluate the paper's scientific quality, structure, methodological rigor and its contribution to the field of educational research. The reviewer will nt be members of the journal editorial board. Anonymity authors and evaluators will be guaranteed during the evaluation process. Authors will be informed regarding the result of the evaluation process by email. Papers can be rejected, approved with changes (major or minor) or accepted for publications.

If there is disagreement with the evaluation made by the peer reviewers, the author or authors will be able to appeal in a reasoned way before the Journal Editor and the Editorial Committee will take appropriate measures, which will be reported to the author via email.

#### Authorship policy

**IKASTORRATZA.** *e-Revista de Didáctica* does not accept papers with more than five authors. Signatories of the paper are supposed to have substantially contribute to the development work. Taking part in data collection or in the implementation of a technique for getting data is not, by itself, enough criteria for authorship. Overall, the followings are the requirements that should be considered for authorship:

- · Have contributed to the plan and implementation of activity that has resulted in the manuscript.
- · Have taking part in writing the paper and in its revisions.
- · Have approved the final version of the paper that will be published.

*IKASTORRATZA. e-journal on Didactics* waives any liability for possible disputes arising from the authorship of the works published.

#### Plagiarism and data fabrication

Plagiarism is not admissible in IKASTORRATZA. e-journal on Didactics.

Plagiarism refers to copying content from other writings or taking pictures, data or even ideas without acknowledging the original document. Authors should also consider that copying own publications is not acceptable.

When authors need to reuse text from other sources, they have to introduce it between quotation marks and to cite the original document. In addition, authors have to explicitly cite previous papers, books or studies when those have been a source of inspiration regarding the structure, content, language or design of the authors' own work.

All the submissions that Ikastorratza. e-journal on Didactics receives are going to be checked for plagiarism. To that end, the Editorial Committee will use turnitin.com software or that tool which the University of the Basque Country could provide the Editorial Committee with. Detecting plagiarism throughout the peer review process will imply the withdrawal of the manuscript.

Authors are cautioned that data presented in their paper must be original and not incorrectly chosen, shaped, improved, or fabricated. Similarly, figures and images presented in the paper are must be truthful and accurate. Failure to comply with these principles implies the withdrawal of the paper.
