It is a vibrant city with many inhabitants from all over the world. Despite its size, it doesn't feel huge and one can really feel at home fast. The city is really open and if you want and feel like it; making new friends is very well possible. As in every big city, less good things happen in Amsterdam, but generally it is a very safe city with many parks and we even have the Amsterdam Forest. We have many festivals. The climate has its variations, it can be cold, windy and rainy but frequently the climate can be friendly and dry, summers can be even warm by times. No year is the same.  The public transport is very good; Bus, tram, metro and train take you everywhere if needed and since Holland is not so big- you can easily plan daytrips to other cities. Next to that; Amsterdam is the city of bikes, so if you practice a bit; you can save some money because the public transport isn't the cheapest.  If you want a room/house under 600 euro per month; the best thing is to arrange a flat when you arrive (this was explained by our foreign employees) and stay a little while in hotels/hostels or air bnb-places. Searching something from abroad is not so easy.  Our office is situated in the Centre-West part of Amsterdam in the new Harbour development area called 'Houthavens' and it takes around 10 minutes to really get into the citycentre from there. Special is that we are situated on the third floor in a building with media and art companies with a spectacular view over the harbour skyline of Amsterdam. It is a modern building and we have a bright and light office.

Loes Thijssen As partner and creative director Loes Thijssen (1990; graduated with honours in TU Delft) runs the research department of the office and directs the office strategy. Loes is also involved in larger complex projects and competitions. Her interest lies in adaptive environments and future cities.  Strenghts/ Experience/ Specialisation NOAHH is specialized in complex projects, such as cultural and leisure buildings, spatial organisation and multifunctional accommodations of different sizes. The Culture Cluster (Amare) in The Hague and the Music Centre TivoliVredenburg in Utrecht and Theater a/d Parade in 's Hertogenbosch, Glanerbrook Sportspark in Geleen are recent examples of its
