Ormston House is located in the heart of Limerick City and on the edge of a key zone for regeneration under the Limerick 2030 economic and spatial plan. The city centre was awarded the Purple Flag for providing a vibrant and diverse mix of dining, entertainment and culture while promoting safety and well-being of visitors and local residents. The average monthly rent for a room in shared accommodation is €600. Ormston House will assist the trainee with temporary accommodation on arrival (up to two weeks) and support with finding suitable accommodation for the duration of the traineeship. The city centre is manageable on foot however there is also a public bicycle scheme, a bus service, an intercity train service, and an international airport 20 minutes from the city.
