

KEYS TO DEVELOPING ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY FOR ENGLISH MEDIUM HIGHER EDUCATION (C2 LEVEL)

Introduction: Who is the course for?

This advanced level course (Common European Framework C2 level) is designed to further the English-medium skills of university lecturers and researchers who have an advanced level of English proficiency. .

Participants should have a strong C1+ level of English.

Course Objective:

Participants will have the opportunity to focus on English in higher education contexts by carrying out a variety of written and spoken tasks in and out of class.

Learning opportunities

- develop fluency and confidence in their oral interaction and speaking skills by engaging in the debate and discussion of topics and situations relating to Higher Education.
- increase the accuracy and effectiveness of their English by reviewing language points and lexical areas pertaining to the C2 level and that are relevant to the Higher Education context, teaching and learning.
- expand their awareness of current international academic and cultural areas of interest and deliberation.
- view tools and resources for further professional development.

Course assessment:

To have successfully completed the course, participants will be required to:

- complete at least 80% of the 15 hours of the course.
- complete the set tasks.
- participate actively in class.

Course duration:

The course consists of 6 x 2.5 hour sessions on Tuesdays. (15 hours)
