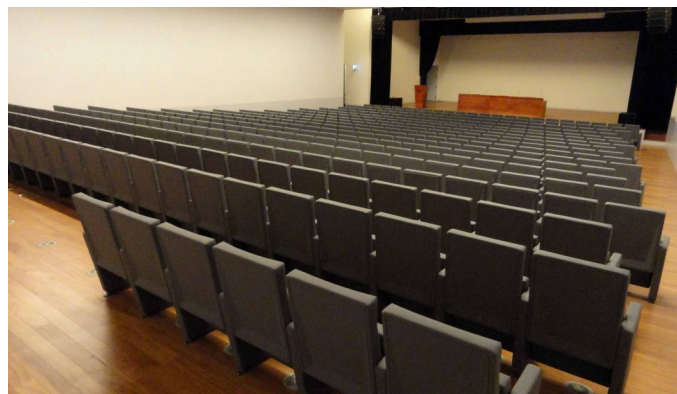
The City of Bilbao
