## Summary of work line 1 meeting of the ToShare Observatory on Derived requirements in terms of fair distribution of the wealth of compliance with Human Rights and the SDGs

Held on Friday, March 29, between 9:00 and 11:00 am, at the Deanery (3rd floor) of the Faculty of Labour Relations and Social Work of the UPV/EHU.

Attend: Isa Álvarez (As. Baladre), Ainhoa Saitua ((UPV / EHU) and Ángel Elías (UPV / EHU). Excuse their absence: Txaro Goñi (Economists without Borders), Amaia Ibarrondo (Emmaus Foundation) and Sofía Marroquín (Oxfam / Intermon).

In the meeting, according to the order of the day sent, the following topics are treated:

- 1) Information about the steps that been made in the Observatory: contact with entities of which already 23 participate, creation of 6 working groups that meet this week, 12 students who work as volunteers, the website that is currently in Basque and Spanish but soon it will also be in English, and preparation for its delivery in the next days of the newsletter. Likewise, the idea of creating a forum on the website, which allows it to be extended on social networks.
- 2) A presentation is made of what each one works in relation to this topic. The wealth of the group and the very complementary perspectives are verified coinciding in the need to sensitize and to form, as well as to encourage the realization of investigations like Degree Final Projects that deepen in this subject.
- 3) In possible contributions, several documents and publications are shared, highlighting the clarity and requirement of art. 2.1 of the International Covenant on ESCR that literally states: "Each of the States Parties to the present Covenant undertakes to take measures, both separately and through international assistance and cooperation, especially economic and technical, to the maximum extent possible, to progressively achieve, by all appropriate means, including in particular the adoption of legislative measures, the full effectiveness of the rights recognized herein". Likewise, within the strategy of Corporate Social Responsibility Law 11/2018, in compliance with Directive 95/2014, it obliges companies with more than 500 workers to offer non-financial information.
- 4) As a coordination proposal, a summary of the meeting will be sent, permanent contact will be maintained by email and, when deemed convenient, also in person.
- 5) Other topics mention that one of the projects of the Campus bizi lab call of the UPV / EHU uses a simulator created by a company with didactic purposes with students of different degrees, which allows the development of transversal competences, such as critical and systemic knowledge.
