Summary of work line 4 meeting of the ToShare Observatory on the knowledge of the distribution of wealth

Held on Tuesday, March 26, between 9:00 and 10:00 am, at the Deanery (3rd floor) of the Faculty of Labour Relations and Social Work of the UPV/EHU.

Attend: Mª Luz de la Cal (UPV/EHU) and Ángel Elías (UPV/EHU). Excuse their absence: Sofía Marroquin (Oxfam-Intermon) y Jon Bernat Zubiri (UPV/EHU).

In the meeting, according to the order of the day sent, the following topics are treated:

- 1) Information about the steps that been made in the Observatory: contact with entities of which already 23 participate, creation of 6 working groups that meet this week, 12 students who work as volunteers, the website that is currently in Basque and Spanish but soon it will also be in English, and preparation for its delivery in the next days of the newsletter. Likewise, the idea of creating a forum on the website, which allows it to be extended on social networks.
- 2) A presentation is made of what each one works in relation to this topic.
- 3) In possible contributions it is considered that Oxfam-Intermon has been working for some time on this subject, so Sofía can play a role of reference. The importance of sensitizing and training is discussed, as well as being able to address what in each society and historical moment is considered a fair distribution of wealth, in contrast to existing and perceived reality.
- 4) As a coordination proposal, a summary of the meeting will be sent and permanent contact will be maintained by email and, when deemed convenient, also in person. Sofia will act as a facilitator, sharing materials and promoting a debate on this topic in the Forum.
- 5) Other topics mention the importance of favoring contacts with students who may be dealing with this topic and with other researchers.
