The UPV/EHU Library Catalogue

The UPV/ EHU Library catalogue is based on OCLC's WorldCat Discovery, the world's most comprehensive database of information about library collections with over 3 thousand million electronic, digital and physical resources.

It allows you to access all library resources with a single search: books, e-books, journal titles in print and electronic formats, articles, digital collections, content from various databases, and the ADDI Repository, among others.

You can access full texts directly from any device and from any location if you sign in.

If you are on the UPV/EHU data network, you will be able to access the full text without signing in.

If you sign in, you will have additional functionalities such as viewing your loans, managing reservations, or creating and managing document lists.

There is a set of tools on the left side of the screen that allows you to filter by libraries, formats, year of publication, language, subject (don't forget to expand the "More" option if you can't find it)

Sign in

Sign in with your ID and password or otherwise click on **set/reset password**: click on the link sent to your UPV/EHU university email address (the one provided by the university) and type in the password you chose.




Search

Type the keywords in the search bar; you can also search by book title, journal, author, etc.

Press Enter or click the Search button.

By default, the results correspond to the holdings of the UPV/EHU and can be sorted by best match. If you prefer not to limit the results to our library, you can change the options using the filter "Held By Library > Libraries Worldwide".




Search results

Use the filters present on the left-hand side column after your search, if you need to refine the results.

Narrow the search by selecting, for example: "Format > Book," "Publication Year > Last 10 years." The filters used will be displayed in the top bar, where you can remove them or keep them for future searches.

Once the filters are applied, the number of results will decrease.



Limiting your Search

You can also limit your search using operators along with the keywords in the search box:

Quotation marks ("") to search for the exact phrase or expression.

Wildcards for variations of the same word:


- *searches for any word that starts with those characters (e.g., Child* retrieves documents containing child, children, etc.)
- # replaces a single character (e.g., Wom#n retrieves both woman and women)
- > ? replaces 0 to 1 characters (e.g., Colo?r retrieves colour or color


Finding a Book, Print Edition

To see the location and availability of copies, click on the title. A window will open containing the complete record information, and on the right, there will be a box labeled "Access Options." Here, you will see the details of the first copy and the total number of available copies. The full list of copies will indicate if they are available for loan, for inlibrary use only, or if they are currently on loan, in which case the return date will be provided.

If the book is on loan or in a different library than yours, you can make a request.


Please note: Only documents in the "Long Loan" category can be requested for interlibrary loan.





Finding and accessing eBooks

Search with the terms you want and access the full text through the link; if you are only interested in electronic format documents, you can filter by that group:




Finding a Journal/Magazine, Print Edition

You need to search by the Journal/Magazine title; you can limit the Format to Journal/Magazine in the filter list on the left.

Click on the title, and a window with more details will open.

Go to Availability (at the bottom) to find out in which library it is available and which issues/volumes/years of that title exist in each of them.


Journals/Magazines cannot be checked out; they are always for in-room consultation, although there is the possibility of photocopying or scanning the article you are interested in.



Finding an eJournal/eMagazine, direct access

Enter the title in the search box and use the filters to limit your search: Format > Journal/Magazine > eJournal/eMagazine.

Click on the blue button to link to the electronic text (Access Journal), and you will be taken directly to the content; search by year, volume, issue, etc., to find the article you need.



Finding an eJournal, LDAP access

In some cases, access is not direct and you will be asked to sign in with LDAP to view the content.
