Being the capital of Denmark, Copenhagen has a wide variety of activities and cultural offers available. It is also ideally located so its inhabitants can easily access Sweden through Malmö across the Øresund bridge. As in many capital cities, the accommodation market is quite competitive but the construction of new buildings and community housing allow people to find accommodation quite easily. An extended offer for short/medium stay is available online through social media. The most used way to get around in Copenhagen is by bike. You can easily buy one second hand or rent one with monthly memberships. Leaving your bike outside remains quite safe compared to other cities. Copenhagen also has a strong public transport network with metro, trains and buses working 24/7. The airport is also very close to the city and is accessible by a 20 min metro ride. The city is by the sea and offers a wide range of outdoor activities. You can enjoy the beach, the canals and many parks in and around the city. Additionally, you can enjoy the cosy cafe and world class architecture. CPH:DOX office is located in Copenhagen city centre in the bussing Meatpacking district. The area hosts many creative offices by day and is the epicentre of Copenahgen nightlife at night.

MAIN ACTIVITY OF THE COMPANY/INSTITUTION	CPH:DOX doesn't just show documentary films – we anchor them in social context through debates, artist talks, events and masterclasses. In the hope of creating real social transformation, CPH:DOX establishes a space for reflection, dialogue and opinion across our society, making sure that the films and their themes stay with the viewers long after the films have ended. CPH:DOX also caters for the established film and media industry, as well as new artists, with our 5-day industry event CPH:CONFERENCE, CPH:MARKET, CPH:LAB, and our international financing and co-production event CPH:FORUM.
A BRIEF EXPLANATION OF MAIN PROJECTS	CPH:DOX festival runs for 10 days in March (next edition from 19-30 March 2025). During this period the festival is engaged in a diverse range of activities: film screening and events to the general audience, catered events for industry professionals (co-production pitching forum, conferences and other industry and networking activities). The festival is mainly happening in Copenhagen but has also engaged for several years in its DOX:DENMARK activities where films are screened in 40+ municipalities across the country. The rest of the year, some of the documentaries featured at CPH:DOX are available online on the festival streaming platform PARA:DOX.
