The city centre was awarded the Purple Flag for providing a vibrant and diverse mix of dining, entertainment and culture while promoting safety and well-being of visitors and local residents.</p> <p>The average monthly rent for a room in shared accommodation is €650. Ormston House will assist the trainee with temporary accommodation on arrival (up to two weeks) and support with finding suitable accommodation for the duration of the traineeship. The city centre is manageable on foot, however there is also a public bicycle scheme, a bus service, an intercity train service, and an international airport 20 minutes from the city.</p>

Our programme is co-designed with artists and citizens, resulting in community partnerships, multi-annual projects, and cultural events that are responsive to the city and its context. We have developed a participatory model to connect curatorial practice with local knowledge and activism.</p> <p>Ormston House is part of the Irish Network Against Racism, the Irish Museums Association, and the Public Participation Network. International connectivity is also key to our work, and we are active members of two European networks: Artist-Run Network Europe and Trans Europe Halles.
