





Incoming Graduate students

Coming to Brazil

All students and researchers should be aware of those items that are essential for a smooth stay in Brazil. Those are:



Welcome Day (for Undergraduate) / First Attendance (for Graduate)

Please attend the Welcome Day (if you are a Undergraduate student) or visit the International Cooperation Office to inform UFF of your arrival. It is a mandatory step.



Student visa

Every foreign student or researcher doing mobility at UFF must arrive in Brazil with a Student Visa. See more at www.portalconsular.itamaraty.gov.br/vistos (available in Portuguese and English).



Health Insurance

A mandatory procedure taken in your country of origin (that must be valid during the whole period of your stay in Brazil) and it must be presented at the International Cooperation Office upon your arrival.



Enrollment in Courses (for Undergraduate students)

The Study Plan made on your online application is provisory. The enrollment for the semester will be done at the International Cooperation Office.



National Migratory Registry

The *National Migratory Registry* (RNM in Portuguese) is mandatory and must be obtained at the Federal Police of Brazil on the first 90 days upon your arrival. Read more at <http://bit.ly/PF-RNM> (available only in Portuguese).

Life at UFF: Our Facilities

UFF is the main cultural spot in Niterói, with an Arts Center that hosts international festivals and has always been praised by its high-quality equipments and spaces. The university also offers a wide range of facilities and initiatives, including:

- Shuttle buses between campuses;
- An innovation agency (Agir);
- University Farm;
- University Pharmacy;
- An Inclusion and Accessibility Office (Sensibiliza); and
- International studies centers.

At UFF, students are also encouraged to take part in extracurricular activities such as LGBTQI+ groups, religious meetings, women and race equality groups, athletics (sports associations), students' associations, extension projects and other initiatives.



International Study Groups

Our professors and students develop initiatives to enhance their researches along with their pairs in other countries.



African Studies Group (NEAF)

NEAF gathers professors, students and researchers from UFF and other universities developing researches on African people diaspora and the impact of African presence in Americas. The center is coordinated by an interdisciplinary team of Literature and History.



Galician Studies Group (NUEG)

The Galician Studies Group works to promote the Galician language, literature and culture at UFF. NUEG offers extension courses, workshops, seminars and academic research. The Group is the result of a partnership with Santiago de Compostela University and Xunta de Galicia.



BRICS Countries Studies Group (NEBRICS)

The Group emerged from a concern amongst of BRICS countries (Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa) to radically transform the world map of education, bringing people back to school, establishing learning centers and world-class researches while promotes the innovation. It starts in dialog with the BRICS Universities League, which is a platform of bilateral and multilateral collaboration between BRICS universities.



Center for Languages and Culture

As the International Cooperation Office is well aware, the language barrier poses an issue to all forms of international relations. Bearing that in mind, and with the intention of opening our institution even further to the world, the *Center for Languages and Culture* launched initiatives for strengthen our multilingual activities for incoming mobility students, with the following activities:

Portuguese for Foreigners

Foreign students can learn Portuguese through four different ways:

- Crash Course (30 hours, from two weeks to one month); or
- Regular Course (60 hours, for a full semester).

Classes can happen online or on-site.

Foreign Languages Universalization Program (PULE)

The PULE aims to teach foreign languages to UFF students who benefit from social assistance grants, enhancing their academic and professional training and helping them to take part in the internationalization process. The program offers courses on six languages (German, Spanish, English, French, Italian, and Russian) and six different levels.

Confucius Classroom

UFF is the proud host of a Confucius Classroom made in partnership with the Hebei Normal University and the Confucius Institute, in China. Students and people from Niterói have the opportunity to learn Chinese language and culture with native teachers.


Writing Center (CITE)


falaMUNDO

Our learning program, where UFF and foreign students learn Portuguese and other languages by practicing in a conversational matter, using Tandem methodology.


Mobility Flow: Outgoing Undergraduate




Mobility Flow: Outgoing Undergraduate




Mobility Flow: Outgoing Undergraduate




Mobility Flow: Incoming Undergraduate



Mobility Flow: Incoming Undergraduate


