Ghost hunters aren't the same as mediums. We use audio recorders, cameras and electromagnetic devices to detect the presence of ghosts. But I think it helps if you have an open mind and a spirit of adventure.

I.: So it's not just a big con? You're not just filling up people's minds with a lot of nonsense in return for their money?

C.: Well, I realise some people see it like that, and that's a shame. But as I see it, I'm no different from a plumber or an electrician. If someone has a problem in their house, they call me, and I come over with the right equipment and some skills, and I can solve their problem..

I.: So what do you recommend that people should do if they feel their house is haunted?

C.: They can contact me via my website and arrange for a consultation. And I'm also happy to take people out on hunts if they want a spooky experience!

I.: Well, Carlene, it's been most interesting talking to you. Thanks very much for coming in.
